Combination packs?

Home kit - Small block. This kit is for blocks up to about 600 sqm . Consists of 1 TermiteTrap carton (6 Traps) and 1 carton of Colony Killer Termite Bait (10 feeders).

\$495 includes delivery by Australia Post.

Home Kit - Medium Block. This kit is for blocks up to about 1200 sqm. Consists of 2 TermiteTrap cartons (12 Traps) and 1 carton of Colony Killer Termite Bait (10 feeders).
