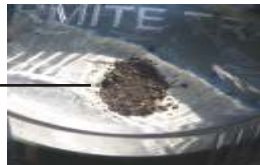
Here's why you save...

- Firstly, you don't have to pay for a Pest Manager to come and inspect the Traps; a gardener or committee member can do it because:
 - The termites give themselves away by mudding over a hole in the cardboard bait to block out the light coming through the window.
 - The patented window at the top of the trap, lets anyone inspect for mud any time they walk past and no experience is necessary.
- Installation is do-it-yourself with a spade.
- Only when termites have arrived, is a non toxic treatment pack added to the Trap. Full instructions in the pack.
- You can re-set the TermiteTraps and keep using them as a monitoring system for 10+ years.

Here's how it works



The window at the top serves two purposes: termites just have to block out the light coming into their banqueting area; it's what they do. Secondly, from our side, we can easily see any mud speckles which indicates they have arrived... thousands of them... enough to take sufficient poison back home to the colony to kill the queen, and the whole nest is dead in a few weeks.



Being mostly above ground level is important. The contaminant can be added without disturbing the termites. They can't help but take the contamination back and that's what kills off the whole colony.

Even the easily frightened species keep working.

Groundlevel

Termites enter through the slots below ground level. Most of the termite action is in the top few inches of the soil.

PATENTED

Termites go looking for food sources. They don't accidentally bump into wood while burrowing through soil. They find TermiteTraps the same way they find plant stakes, posts, bits of wood and buildings. Once a colony is established, scouts are sent out to find new food. They then build an underground tunnel to it from the closest part of their current activity. The cardboard bait is easier to harvest than wood so they turn up in large numbers. It's almost a feeding frenzy!

Here's what it costs...

- \$678 for a minimum 24 TermiteTraps. You own them and there is no on-going fee. A 5-dose treatment: \$150.
- The inspections cost you nothing.
- The treatment is virtually foolproof and should result in the demise of a termite colony. When you eliminate colonies, you eliminate the threat and it takes 3 - 5 years for a start-up colony to build up sufficient numbers to become a new threat. If colonies survive the first 2 years they will usually make the big time!
- The only maintenance which may be required is to maybe replace the cardboard... Years from now.

How many will you need?

Spacing is dependent on the challenge from likely termite sources.

- If termites have already been noted in some areas, spacing could be down to 2-3 metres apart until there has been a successful colony kill.
- Where there is no termite history, spacing could be 5-8 metres apart.

Easy installation

Choose gardens rather than lawn areas.
Stay away from the walls by 300mm (1 foot)
Dig a hole about 250mm (10 inches) deep.
Stand them vertically and tamp down soil.
