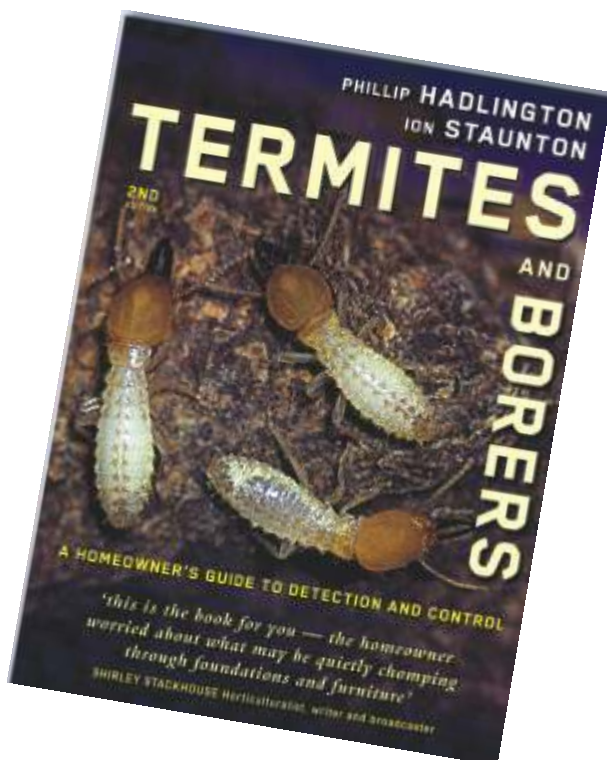

But, as well over 90% of colonies that attack houses come from surrounding areas, what I can claim is a very high probability that termite colonies will find at least one of your Traps.
